Julianne Moore's performance in that powerful film brought her the Best Actress Academy award. Clark says, "My goal in writing this book was to share my story in an effort to inspire and educate people about the devastating effects of Alzheimer's. I never dreamed it would be made into a major motion picture. But with this endeavor that goal can be further enhanced."

The release date has not yet been announced. The screen adaptation has already begun and should be done by June and the cast selected by the end of summer.
